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## HOMEWORK POLICY

Homework will be relevant and purposeful, linked to classwork. In general, homework will follow on from work done in class; it could consist of further practice, a game, or a puzzle. Homework may sometimes consist of preparation for work yet to be done; for example measuring a bedroom before drawing a scale plan at school, or collecting some data ready to draw a graph. The work will sometimes involve the participation of parents; with younger children this is essential.

Homework is seen as a vehicle to help reinforce classwork, usually it will be given to the class, but occasionally it will be given to groups or individuals if the need arises. Homework is a link between home and school reflecting work done in class.

We encourage all children to read at home each day. Reading books and reading records for parents' comments are taken home daily.
