## **Phased re-opening of school – Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 - Parent Information**

Dear Parents / Carers,

I am sending this information out to all families so that everyone is aware of how we will be operating in school in-line with government guidance from the 1<sup>st</sup> June assuming that the phased re-opening of schools happens.

Thank you for providing the information we have required in order to plan for the re-opening of school for children in Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 6 from the 1<sup>st</sup> June. If circumstances change, please let me know either by phoning school or emailing [admin@dishforthairfield.n-yorks.sch.uk](mailto:admin@dishforthairfield.n-yorks.sch.uk).

We are looking forward to seeing your child / children on the 1<sup>st</sup> June. The children will be in their classes with staff that they know or who they are familiar with – EYFS children will be taught by Miss Hunt who is covering Mrs Dixon for this term.

**Please ensure your child brings their work pack into school with them.**

**We would like the children to wear their school uniform on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays. Children are to wear sport kit on a Tuesday and Thursday. Following guidance, children need to have freshly laundered clothes on each day.**

The Local Authority have provided all North Yorkshire schools with a risk assessment to complete. As a school we have worked through this and put the following measures in place to ensure the safety of all children, staff, parents and carers.

Please note the following measures will be in place and need adhering to from the 1<sup>st</sup> June:

- **Only one parent to drop off and pick up at the designated time – parent to take child to the classroom**
- **Where possible walk or cycle to school**



- Please do not bring other siblings to school unless you are unable to leave them at home
- Any need to speak to office staff please telephone – do not come into the school building
- Parents to adhere to social distancing between themselves
- If your child is unwell do not send them to school.
- If you or your child displays symptoms of coronavirus please do not come to school but inform us of the symptoms and get tested – inform school of the outcome

Following guidance, we are implementing a staggered start and finish to the school day – please see the timetable below. Parents are to drop off and collect their child from the classroom as indicated.

Year group	Location	Start and finish times
Nursery – (FS1) * Reception (FS2)	EYFS unit	9.30am – 2.30pm
Year 1	Year 1 PCU	9.15am – 2.45pm
Year 6	Year 5/6 – enter using the fire door to the classroom	8.45am – 3.15pm

**Nursery sessions:** if your child attends a morning session only then this is from 9.30am – 11.45am  
 If your child attends an afternoon session only then this is from 11.45am- 2.30pm  
 All day session 9.30am – 2.30pm
