



Information for Parents

At Dishforth Airfield Primary School every teacher works hard to differentiate the learning according to the ability and needs of each child in the class to ensure every child is enthused to learn and has the necessary challenge and support to do this.

Separate activities and interventions, as discussed as part of a child's Individual Provision Map (IPM) are also catered for and planned by the teacher. Interventions are delivered by highly trained Teaching Assistants (TA) who follow a structured and well planned programme to ensure the best possible progress can be made.

Parents should be kept informed about their child's progress regularly and if outside agencies are involved, meetings will be arranged for parents to come into school and meet all professionals involved with their child.

The Individual Provision Map is a document which is personal to each child. Details of any interventions, successful (and perhaps not so successful) strategies are documented and updated as a personal record for each child. This is a key document for anyone working with a child as it contains all the necessary information about the provision that has been made. The document is highly useful in terms of transitions to highlight what provision has been put into place and been successful and this document is also referred to by outside agencies and professionals.
