

Dear Parents / Carers.

I hope you had a lovely weekend and were able to take advantage of the beautiful weather we are enjoying at the moment.

Class News:

EYFS: This week Early Years have been monkeying about as part of the You're Going to Hear Me Roar launch. They followed clues to find a monkey in the Early Years outdoor area and have been learning all about what makes monkeys so good at living in the jungle as well as painting monkey faces. It's been a busy and fun first week back!

Year 1/2: This week Year 1 and 2 have had an exciting start to their new term - we were animal detectives following paw prints around school through our classroom and into the learning garden, where we found a lion cub. We have written a recount in English and have been very creative in making animals using salt dough and college.

Year 3/4: This week we discovered that some animals had escaped onto the school grounds. We managed to follow a map to find clues which helped us work out that one of the animals was a snake! We have since been researching snakes and writing our own information pages about snakes in literacy. We have also enjoyed working as a team to Papier Mache a giant model of a snake for our school corridor display.

Year 5/6: We have had a wonderful first week back in year 5/6! We started the week with some orienteering to find clues to work out the animals we would be studying. We also found out all about elephants and have written some excellent non-fiction texts using our own research.
