### Class News:

**EYFS:** This week Early Years have been reading the story The Bog Baby and thinking about what a perfect Bog Baby habitat might look like. They have been doing some super writing about what a Bog Baby needs and designing a habitat which they will create in 3D next week.

**Year 1/2:** This week we have been creating our own ending to the story of The Way Home for Wilf. The children have enjoyed adding their own animals and twists and turns. We have continued to focus on fractions learning how to find half and quarters of different amounts. In computing we have been learning to log on and off on the netbooks and using 2paint to create pictures.

## End of key stage assessments – Year 2 and Year 6

The national curriculum assessments due to be held in summer 2021, including tests for children in Year 2 and Year 6 and also the Year 1 phonics screening check, have been cancelled.

Assessment in school happens all the time - during every lesson, teachers are assessing how the children are meeting the objectives set and they keep records of this throughout the year that capture this formative assessment. In addition to this, every term in line with the school's assessment policy, children take a summative assessment in reading and maths which is used to support judgements.

Children in Years 2 and 6 will continue to be assessed as they have been throughout the year and they will also have the opportunity to take a past assessment paper in order to support teacher assessment at the end of the summer term.
