Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week in EYFS we have been working hard practising our Nativity ready to show everyone next week! We have learnt about the story of Christmas and have been sequencing it from memory. We have also been making Christmas decorations, wrapping presents in Santa's workshop and writing Christmas cards to our friends.

Please always assume school is open unless you hear via any of the above methods. Please do not phone the school to ask if we are open as we may need to keep the line clear in order to contact staff. Please check on the school Facebook page and check emails. Learning would be sent home via the class email system.
