History/Geography

For the first half of the Summer Term, we will be exploring the world of the Anglo Saxons and the Vikings. We will be learning about this historic period using secondary sources.



After half term, we will be finding out about global trade and how countries trade between each other.



PE

We will be doing dance with Miss Rich and tennis.

RE/PSHCE

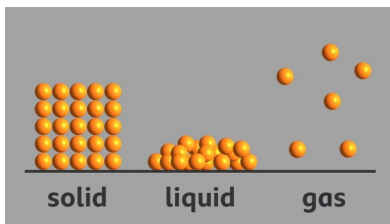
In RE, during the Summer term, we will be learning about what it means to be a Muslim in Britain today.

In PSHCE, we shall be learning about puberty and 'moving on'.



Science

In the Summer term, we will be learning about 'Properties and Changes of Materials'. We will be carrying out investigations and scientific enquiries in our science lessons.



Art/DT

We start off the summer term with an art topic where we will learn how to print using lino.

After half term, we will be doing a DT project where we design, make and evaluate a moving fairground ride.



Literacy

During the summer term, we will be reading a text linked to our class history topic. We will be doing a range of writing linked to the text and also stand alone pieces. We will continue to focus on our SPAG skills throughout each piece.

Numeracy

This term we will be securing our knowledge of fractions, decimals and percentages. We will also be continuing to investigate ratio, algebra, geometry and measuring. We will keep returning to our written methods. Each lesson, we will also continue to work on problem solving and reasoning skills throughout each topic.



Computing

We be learning about being travel writers and after half term we move to learn about publishing.

We will also learn about E-Safety and to keep safe online ensuring we know what to do if we are worried about things online.



Music

We will be continuing to learn the clarinet with Mrs Rhodes whilst learning to read and compose music.



Homework

Spellings and Mental Maths will be handed out every Friday and will be tested the following Friday. I will put the spellings each week onto Spelling Shed. Children will also receive a Maths and Reading Comprehension each week. This will be handed out on a Friday and expected in on a Wednesday to be marked. It is also very important for children to read every day at home and to write it in their diary and bring this to school daily.
