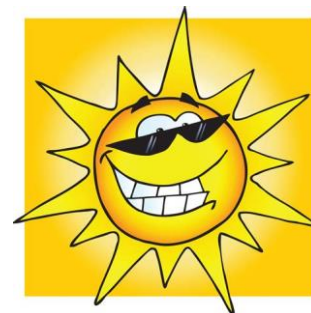

Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you have had a lovely weekend. This Thursday we have a PE workshop in school so ALL children need their PE kits in addition to their usual PE days.

We are due for some very warm weather this week, particularly Wednesday – Friday. Please can you ensure that your child / children has sun protection on them before they come to school and that you have provided sun cream for them to have in school – thank you.

Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have been reading the story 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'. We have been creating lists of food we would like in a picnic lunch and thinking about what makes a healthy lunchbox. We have also created a chart of our favourite sandwich fillings by voting for our favourites.

Year 1 and 2 – This week Year 1 and 2 have been polishing their drawing skills, discussing what they know and would like to learn about seaside resorts in the UK, looking at the structure of a variety of animals and practising some of the skills they will need for our sports day later in the term. They have also been getting stuck in to the story of Oliver and the Seawigs, an adventure novel that they will be exploring for the next few weeks. They have written fantastic predictions about what is going to happen next, some were more exciting than the story itself!

Year 3 and 4 – This week in Year 3 and 4 the children have been sweet inventors and have written persuasive adverts. They have also been working on pictograms and bar charts in Maths. In art we have been shading using pencil technique and in science learning about living things and their habitats. The children have filled their marble jar too – well done!



Year 5 and 6 – This week we have been learning about the 5 Pillars of Islam in our RE lesson. We learnt about the Shahada and thought about our own beliefs and how these can shape who we are. We thought about a special message that we would have wanted our parents to say to use when we were born - just like the Shahada in the Muslim faith.

Balance Bikes – EYFS

This morning EYFS had a fantastic time developing their gross motor skills on balance bikes. They learnt about staying safe and protecting their heads by wearing a helmet. They also learnt about how to keep their bodies healthy and which foods are good to eat. The children worked in teams on the bikes and had a go riding around different circuits. By the end of the session lots of children were well balanced on their bikes and moving safely around the playground. Thank you to Dave for his time this morning teaching us all!
