I hope you all had a lovely weekend and enjoyed the sunshine. Just a reminder that school is closed for the children this Friday (24th June) for a staff training day.

Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have been writing and following instructions. We made jam sandwiches where we all had a go spreading the butter and the jam. We then assembled our sandwich and all got to eat one. We thought they were much nicer than the one's Mrs Grinling made in our book 'The Lighthouse Keeper's Lunch'! We have also been working hard in maths looking at the different compositions of numbers.

Year 1 and 2 – This week the children in Year 1/2 have been developing their problem solving and reasoning skills - they have been encouraged to work systematically when solving problems! In English we have continued to explore Oliver's adventures with Iris the mermaid and Cliff the island as they go in search of Oliver's parents. In Art we have continued our learning with the water colour paints learning how to colour mix using primary colours into secondary colours. We had a great discussion about our parents' job roles in PSCHE and how important different jobs are within the community.

Year 3 and 4 – This week in Year 3 and 4 the children have been reading their new book "The Secret of Platform 13" and have asked some exciting questions wondering what will happen next. They have continued to develop their statistics learning in maths, focusing on tables and line graphs. The children have become historians and explored what Victorian schools were like. So lots of super hard work this week! They have had their marble jar treat - a Willy Wonka inspired party.

Year 5 and 6 – This week we have been finding out about how the Anglo Saxons and Vikings lived. We have used secondary sources to answer different research questions about their home life, how they made weapons and what they ate. We also started our new class text, Viking Boy, which we're really enjoying so far!

If you have spare school uniform that you no longer need, please send it washed to the school office and a uniform sale will take place towards the end of the school year.


Makaton sign of the week


