Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you all had a fantastic week and enjoyed the Platinum Jubilee celebrations throughout the Bank Holiday. We have a busy half term ahead as we move towards the end of the academic year with many things to look forward to – please keep checking diary dates at the end of the newsletter.

Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have been learning all about Queen Elizabeth ii in preparation for the Jubilee celebrations. We have learnt about where she lives, what she likes to do and how long she has been Queen for. We have had a go making some of her many residences in our construction area and made some fantastic crowns too. Some of us have also written some super fact sheets about the Queen too.

Year 1 and 2 – This week the children in Year 1/2 have been researching the decades of the 1990's and 2000's - the children have researched lots of interesting facts. We have also been developing our problem solving and reasoning skills in Maths answering 2 step word problems. In Art we have been learning to use the watercolour paints and brushes.

Year 3 and 4 – This week the children in Year 3 and 4 have continued to read 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' and have begun to look at persuasive writing features. In French we have focused on different styles of music and in mathematics we have further developed our learning in relation to time.



Year 5 and 6 – This week, we have been using figurative language to describe a character. We have watched a short clip about a character call Wing. We have generated descriptive vocabulary and used it to write a character description and a short narrative using dialogue.
