Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS – This week we have been busy enjoying our new travel agent's role play. We have been choosing places we would like to visit and discussing what the weather is like at different destinations. We have been creating packing lists for the different climates by cutting out pictures and sticking them on our suitcases. We have also enjoyed hearing about different countries our friends have visited.
