## Literacy

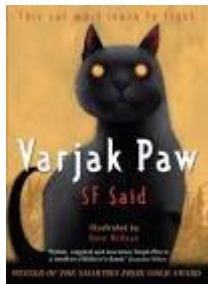
Our whole class reading book this term will be 'Varjak Paw' which we will be using to develop our reading and comprehension skills.
