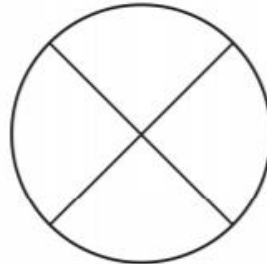

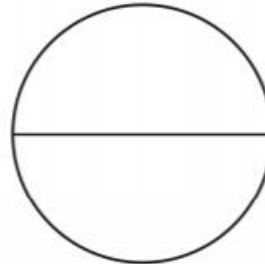

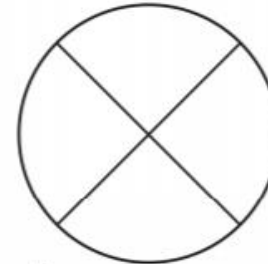
one quarter

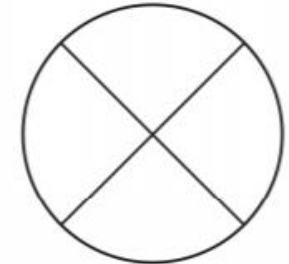
one half

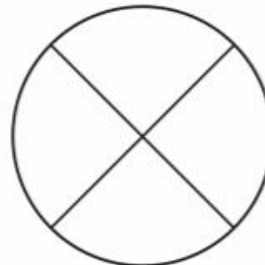

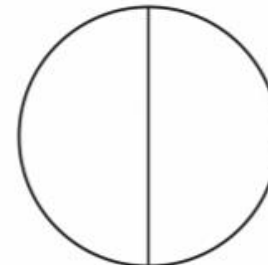
