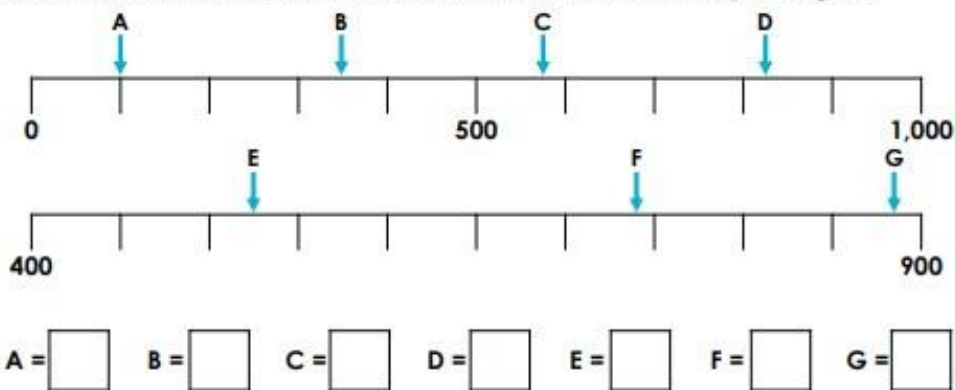
e.g.  $3 \times 6 = 18$  so  $18 \div 6 = 3$

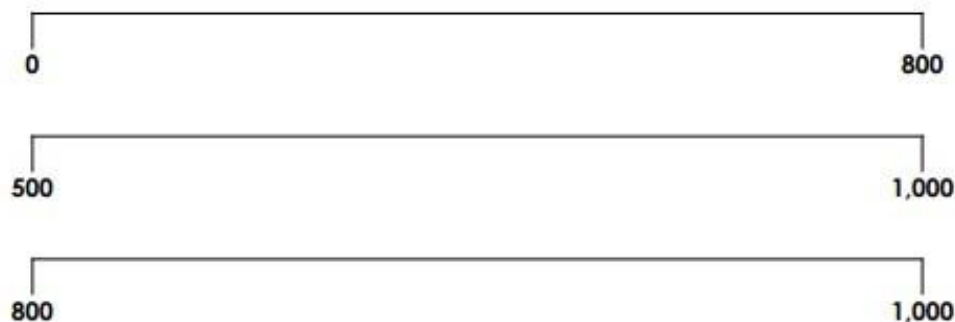


### Estimate on a Number Line to 1,000
