Dear Parents / Carers,

I hope you have all had a lovely autumnal weekend. What a fabulous week we have had in school last week with both Fiji Day and the netball success!

Class News:

Every week the classes will share the highlights of what they have been learning about with our families:

EYFS: This week we have been learning the story 'The Enormous Turnip' the children have enjoyed acting out and retelling the story through role play and small world characters. We have been focusing on weight, size and capacity in our areas of provision which have involved using the balancing scales in our construction area, mud kitchen and little bears porridge area. This has encouraged lots of great mathematical language such as full, empty, light and heavy.

Year 1 and 2: This week has been a busy week for Year 1/2. We have started our new Maths block on Addition and Subtraction and have been learning to use the part-part whole method. In English we have been learning about poetry and we are writing poems linked to harvest. In Art we explored mark making and smudging using the oil pastels - the children had great fun. In PSCHE this week we looked at the Pants programme explaining that what's in our pants are private - we had some very mature conversations around this. On Tuesday we were lucky enough to celebrate Fiji Day with our Fiji families - this is always a great pleasure.

Year 3 and 4: This week we have been mastering column addition in maths and have started to explore column subtraction using resources. We have enjoyed being scientists and investigating which materials are magnetic and which are non-magnetic - some of the results surprised us! We have enjoyed playing 5-a-side matches of football in our PE lessons and did an excellent job of putting all the skills we have been practicing in to play.





















Year 5 and 6: This week we have been exploring the climate of different places in North America. We looked at a number of different countries and we had to match the place and the description together. We then had to use the description to work out which temperatures graph and precipitation graph matched up.

Last Tuesday we celebrated Fiji Day with our Fijian families. A huge thank you to the Fijian community who came to school to share the history of Fiji with the children and the staff, cooked for us and danced with us – thank you!



Weekly Attendance

Good attendance at school is key to your child's progress.

Good attendance is essential for pupils to get the most out of their school experience, including their attainment, wellbeing, and wider life chances. Nationwide research has shown that the pupils with the highest attainment at the end of key stage 2 have had higher rates of attendance throughout primary school, compared to those with the lowest attainment. The government aims for all pupils to have a minimum of 95% attendance across the school year, and any child with less than 90% attendance is recorded as a persistent absentee.
