

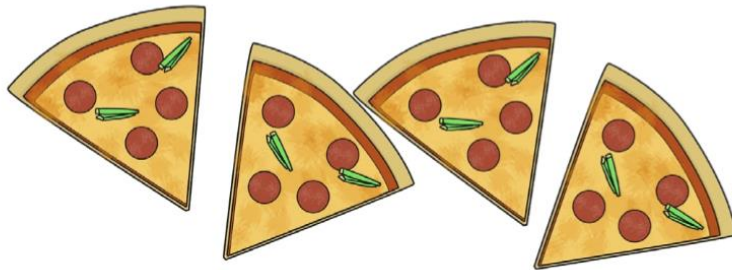

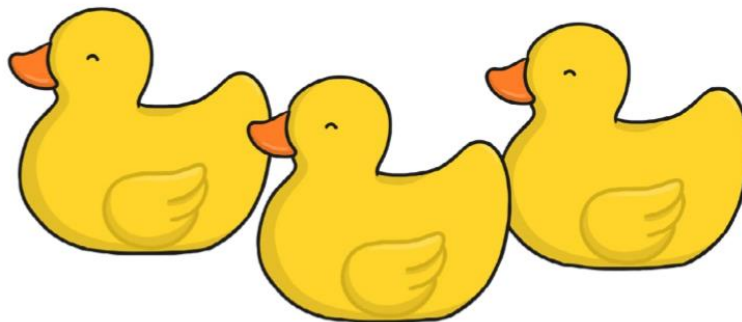
Addition and Subtraction to 100 Word Problems

2. If you have 72 rubber ducks and are given another 17, how many rubber ducks would you have?

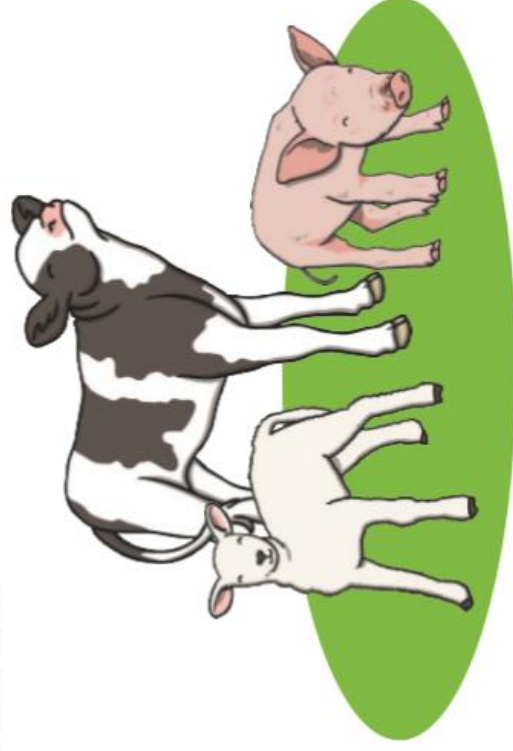


Farmyard Babies

A female pig is called a sow and they can have up to 25 babies in one litter! Their babies are called piglets.

Cows give birth to live young called calves. A calf feeds off its mother's milk for the first eight to ten weeks of its life so that it stays healthy and strong.

A lamb is the name of a baby sheep. The mother sheep is called a ewe. The farmer will normally bring the ewe into a barn to give birth. They can have up to four babies at a time but usually they only have one or two.
