### Science

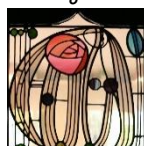
In Science we are going to be learning about living things and their habitats and then exploring materials and their different uses

### English

### Geography

In Geography we are going to be learning about Fiji We will be finding about the physical and human features of the country and making comparisons with a seaside destination in the UK.



### Mathematics

We will work on our place value skills, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division this term. We will also learn about measurement.



### History
