In history this term we will be learning about social justice and how punishments have changed over the years.

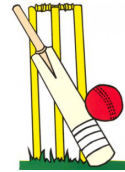


In geography, we will be learning about our local area. We will be doing some mapping of the area and exploring the different physical features with a focus on Ripon.

In PSHCE, we shall be learning about puberty and health and well-being.

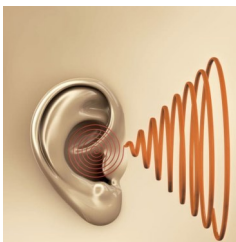


Science

Maths

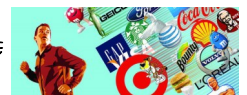
