



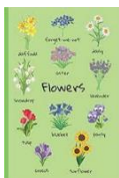
Year 1/2 Curriculum Newsletter

Science

In science this term we will be naming and identify common plants and trees and understanding the functions of different parts of plants. In our Electricity topic we will be finding out about electricity in our home and school as well as creating simple circuits.



Welcome to Year 1/2 we have lots of exciting learning planned for you this term!

Art

In Art we will be exploring the art work of Vincent Van Gogh and developing our coloured pencil skills.

English

We'll explore a range of text types this term including stories, poetry and non-fiction. Through our lessons we will explore a range of characters and settings, we will continue to practice our phonic, reading and writing skills.



Geography

We are going to be exploring the United Kingdom, finding out about the four countries which make up the UK, and learning key facts about each of them as well as the seas which surround us.



Mathematics

We will work on our place value skills up to 100, multiplication and division, statistics, fractions, money, time and geometry. We will practice the skills we have already learnt every week.



History

We are going to be learn about the chronology of Space Travel from the first animals that were sent into Orbit, focussing on Neil Armstrong, Helen Sharman and Tim Peake.



RE

In RE we shall be exploring the religion of Islam and also sacred books.



Music

We shall be learning to play instruments with or without notation. We will also use our voices as an instrument.



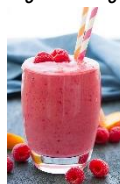
PSHCE
