We will be writing across a range of text types this term such as story writing, poetry, monologues, diary entries, information pages and persuasive writing.

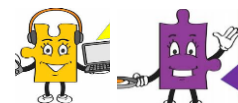
Our work on the Year 3/4 vocabulary, punctuation and grammar learning focuses will be ongoing.
