Welcome to Year 1/2—we have lots of exciting learning planned for you this term!

History

In History we will be learning about The Great Fire of London.



Geography

We will be learning about the oceans around the world and exploring each of the continents.



Science

We shall be learning about materials, sound and seasonal change.



Homework

Children are expected to read daily—please write in the reading dairy.



- Children will need to complete one piece of topic / project homework per week (right hand side of the grid)
- Children will need to practise the key spellings & key maths facts (left hand side of the grid)

Art/ DT

We will be learning to collage and look at how flames are portrayed in art.



In DT we will be building structures and learning how to reinforce the joins.



English

We shall explore a range of text types this term including stories based on our topic. We will be exploring a range of characters and settings. We will continue to practice our phonic, reading and writing skills.



Maths

We will be learning about multiplication, division, properties of shape, length and height and fractions.
