Week 7: Due in 05.03.26	Know by heart all doubles of multiples of 5 up to 100	The y is changed to i before -ed, -er and -est are added <i>copied, copier, happier, happiest, cried, replied</i>
Week 8: Due in: 12.03.26	Know by heart all doubles of multiples of 10 up to 100	The -e at the end of the root word is dropped before -ing, -ed, -er, -est, -y or any other suffix beginning with a vowel letter is added. <i>hiking, hiked, hiker, nicer, nicest, shiny</i>
Week 9: Due in 19.03.26	Know by heart all halves of all multiples of 10 up to 100	The last consonant letter of the root word is doubled to keep the /æ/, /ɛ/, /ɪ ɒ /, / / and /ʌ/ sound <i>patting, patted, runny dropping, dropped, runner,</i>
Week 10: Due in 26.03.26	Know the number of days in a week, month and year	The /ɔ:/ sound ('or') is usually spelt as a before l and ll. <i>all, ball, call, walk, talk, always</i>
Week 11: Due in 16.04.26	Count in fives from any number, forward or backward	The plural of these words is formed by the addition of -s <i>keys, donkeys, valleys monkeys, chimneys,</i>

Imagine you were going with Shackleton to Antarctica. Make a list of what you would pack and explain why you would take it.


Can you write a diary entry from Shackleton's point of view to describe his adventure on the Endurance expedition?

Make a packing list to go on holiday to Fiji. What do you need? What don't you need?


Make a list of the things which are the same and different about Dishforth Airfield and Sigatoka in Fiji
